# 2010 Environmental Art Contest for Newton Students K-5!

New for 2010 -- the Environmental Art Contest, open to Newton students in grades K-5, living or attending school in Newton! Last year over 150 Newton students participated in the Energy Conservation Essay & Art Contests. This year's art contest expands the scope beyond energy conservation to the environment in general and how students are helping their schools and Newton "go green."

## Key dates:

**March 15:** All art entries due

**April 8:** Awards Ceremony at 6:30 pm at War Memorial Auditorium, Newton City Hall

**April 26-May 7:** All contest entries will be exhibited in the rotunda at Newton City Hall

## Guidelines for 2010 contest and prizes

- **Eligibility:** All students in grades K-5 who live or go to school in Newton
  - Entries will be judged with others from the same grade only
  - Register on-line at [www.greendecade.org](http://www.greendecade.org) to enter this year's contest
- **Grades K, 1 and 2:**
  - Teams of 4-6 students enter posters
  - Classrooms may have as many teams as the teacher elects to have
- **Grades 3, 4 and 5: Two options**
  - Teams of 4-6 students enter posters; as many teams per classroom as teacher elects
  - Individuals: may enter posters
- **Artwork: "How Our School Is Helping Newton Go Green"**
  - Teams: Standard poster board size (22" x 28") (Grades K-5)
  - Individuals: 12 "x18" max size (Grades 3-5 only)
  - 2-dimensional
  - Use of recycled materials encouraged
  - May include photographs/collage and text
  - Artwork may be submitted at designated locations (on website)
- **Prizes:** All contestants will receive a certificate of participation and recognized at the awards program.
  - **Team prizes: for each grade (6 first place, 18 Honorable Mention)**
    - 1<sup>st</sup> place: Basket of eco-friendly/non-toxic art supplies (\$50 value) for teacher
    - Three Honorable Mentions: certificate & recognition at awards
  - **Individual winners: Grades 3, 4 and 5 (3 first place, 3 second place, 18 Honorable Mention)**
    - 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$35 check
    - 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$25 check
    - Three Honorable Mentions: certificate & recognition at awards
  - **Art Basket Raffle!**
    - All contestants will be automatically entered into a raffle to win a \$50 eco-art supply basket, name to be drawn at award ceremony. (Note: Prize winners' names will not be entered into raffle.)
